

# GRADUATION AWARD ACHILLE AND GIULIA BOROLI FOUNDATION IN MEMORY OF ACHILLE BOROLI 2019

## Fondazione Boroli and Bocconi University

The relationship between the Achille and Giulia Boroli Foundation and Bocconi is one of reciprocal trust.

Over the last 10 years, the Foundation has provided annual graduation awards to some of our best students. Since 2006 nearly 50 Bocconi graduates have won a Boroli Foundation Graduation Award. In 2012 this relationship expanded with the purpose of involving not only Bocconi students but the entire Milanese community via institutional initiatives like the Bocconi-Boroli Lecture, which is open to the public. The Foundation dedicated the Bocconi-Boroli Lecture to the memory of its founder, Achille Boroli, a man of culture and a notable entrepreneur. These Lectures have been highly prestigious institutional events and have featured renowned European and international speakers.

In 2015 the project "Europeans: Bocconi-Boroli Days" was created to make young people aware of the critical subject of the European Union, strengthen the university debate and share the content with the public at large. Over three years, the initiative has been organized into a series of encounters providing an opportunity to exchange viewpoints. Experts discuss and analyze topics and proposals for a Europe closer to its citizens, one that can inject new trust into the common political and economic pathway. At the last meeting of this initiative, another important contribution of the Foundation was announced: the establishment of a Chair in European Studies at Bocconi. The Chair, assigned to Professor Gianmarco Ottaviano, aims to stimulate the study and dissemination of European themes, not only among Bocconi students but among high school students as well.

### Graduation Award

As part of the Achille and Giulia Boroli Chair in European Studies initiative, the Achille and Giulia Boroli Foundation hereby announces from 1 to 3 graduation awards of the amount of  $\in$  3,000 each reserved to graduates of Master of Science or Integrated Master of Arts programs at Bocconi University who have received a grade of 110 cum laude/110.

Applicants are required to have completed their degree during the **2019** calendar year with a thesis on Europe or the European Union.

The abovementioned award is reserved to applicants who completed their Integrated Master of Arts in Law at Bocconi or to applicants who completed their Bachelor and Master of Science at Bocconi. Applicants from other universities will therefore not be accepted.

The Commission will be chaired by Gianmarco Ottaviano, the Achille and Giulia Boroli Chair holder, and made up of the Chair team members. They will meet to evaluate the competing graduation theses by 30 March 2020.

The Commission's decision is final.
